About 3:30 am, she assured me my husband was stable and if there were any changes, she would call. She had contacted the chaplains to come see me and to administer the sacraments to my husband. Carrie not only was there for my husband, but for me. She gave me hope and showed me the compassion of what a nurse is really all about.*
